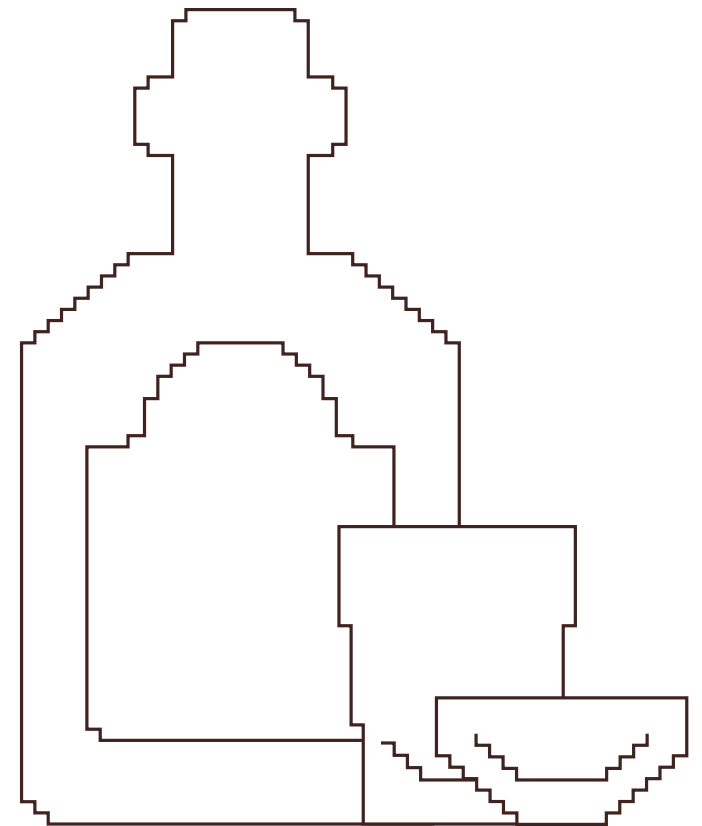

TEQUILA

Tequila is made from cooking, crushing, fermenting and distilling the juice from the agave plant, specifically the blue weber agave. It can be produced in 5 states in Mexico - Jalisco, Michoacán, Nayarit, Guanajuato and Tamaulipas.

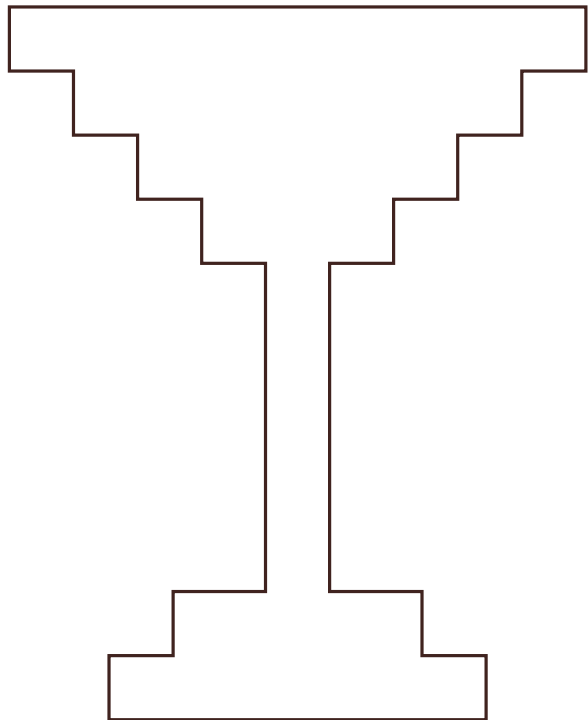

MEZCAL

Mezcal is made from cooking, crushing, fermenting and distilling the juice from the agave plant. There are over 30 different species used for Mezcal. It can be produced in 10 states in Mexico - Oaxaca, Guerrero, Puebla, Michoacán, Guanajuato, San Luis Potosí, Tamaulipas, Zacatecas, Durango and Sinaloa.

RAICILLA, SOTOL, BACANORA

3 traditional Mexican spirits, made from Agave or similar.

Raicilla is similar to Mezcal and Tequila production, but cooked in an above-ground oven and it can only be produced in Jalisco and Nayarit. Sotol is made from the desert spoon plant which is technically not an agave. Can be produced in Chihuahua, Coahuila and Durango. Bacanora comes from the state of Sonora and is made only from the Pacifica agave.
